

ASIA LIFE SCIENCES INFORMATION FOR/GUIDE TO POTENTIAL AUTHORS

ASIA LIFE SCIENCES (ISSN 0117-3375) is a non-stock, non-profit refereed/peer-reviewed (double-blind review) international, scientific journal which welcomes original papers dealing with basic and applied aspects of the Life Sciences and other disciplines. Review articles and contributions of considerable length (more than 40 printed pages) are also welcome; however, arrangement should be made prior to submission.

Manuscripts should be submitted as an *e*-copy using MS Word (1997-2003, 2010 versions) as word processing program. A review process fee of US\$200.00 per submitted paper is required. This should be prepaid through bank transfer payment mode (bank account details to be provided upon request) and *e*-copy of validated bank transaction record should be sent using the *e*-mail address(es) below. Submitted paper will be channelled to peer review (double-blind review) only after receipt of prepayment. Reviewed manuscripts will be returned to author(s) for comments, reply and/or approval of any proposed changes. Author(s) will be requested to make the revisions or alterations on their copy. The revised manuscripts should be returned through *e*-mail within six days after receipt of reviewed manuscripts; otherwise, proposed changes by reviewers may be selectively incorporated by the Editor(s). Subsequent correspondence will be conducted by *e*-mail until the time that the issue where the accepted paper is to be included has been published.

To defray the cost of publication, author(s) of accepted manuscripts would be requested to prepay a publication fee, the exact amount of which will be determined on or before printing time (depending on the total final number of actual printed pages). Author(s) will be informed of this publication fee through a letter of publication acceptance of their manuscripts.

The format of the paper should include the following parts: Title, Author(s) & Institutional Address(es), Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgments and Literature Cited. Harvard system of reference citations [name and date system, e.g. Gruèzo & Harries 1984 or Gruèzo and Harries (1984)] should be used. References should be listed as "LITERATURE CITED" and titles of journals, proceedings, books, theses, etc. should be spelled out in full (= complete title must be provided; do not abbreviate!). Some examples are:

- Gruèzo, Wm.Sm. and H.C. Harries. 1984. Self-sown, wild-type coconuts in the Philippines. *Biotropica 16*(2): 140-147. (for a paper with two authors)

(citation for a chapter or paper appearing in a multi-authored publication)

In addition, a short running title should be provided by the author(s). Illustrations should be referred to as “Figures” in the text. All figures must be accompanied by some indication of scale, preferably a scale bar (in metric system). Indications of magnification in figure captions, e.g. “50x” are not acceptable. For papers that are already accepted for publication, hard copy of figure(s) unmounted and marked on the reversed side with the author’s name, figure number(s) and “TOP” should be provided by the corresponding author upon request of the Chief Editor. Only high quality glossy, black-and-white or color photo prints should be submitted. Line drawings must be done in India ink and with due consideration of the actual printed page of 7 x 4 1/2” or smaller. Please see articles in recent issues for style format sample, particularly citation of references and figures in text.

PREPAYMENT of publication fee entitles the author(s) to one mint hard copy of journal issue and fifteen gratis reprints (without cover) of the paper. Additional copies or reprints (with or without cover) may be provided at cost and order should be made by return of revised accepted manuscripts. Notice of cost of additional reprints will be provided to author(s) as soon as possible or before final printing. All additional orders for bound copy and reprints must be prepaid immediately.

All accepted and published papers become the legal property of *ASIA LIFE SCIENCES*, The Asian International Journal of Life Sciences (ISSN 0117-3375) and the Rushing Water Publishers Limited, copyright owner and publisher of the Journal.
